I am pleased to advise the installation of an on-road segregated bikeway along the eastern side of Worrell St with improved connections at the north and south ends was endorsed by the members attending, as a an interim solution until the next widening of the motorway. At this time we would want to see the V1 made continuous at level with the motorway so people riding bikes can bypass the increased gradient along Worrell St.
