Dear Mr French

Thank you for your email of 8 December 2021 requesting 30km/h speed limits in Brisbane. I apologise for the delay in responding to you.

I appreciate the time you have taken to write to me sharing your thoughts and research you have reviewed.

My Administration has been active in ensuring that safe, credible speed limits have been implemented in areas of high pedestrian activity such as suburban shopping strips across the City. This process started more than a decade ago with the reduction of the CBD speed limit to 40 km/h.

For your interest, speed limits on all roads in Queensland are assessed and set in accordance with the Queensland Government's *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*. This ensures that speed limits are set in a consistent and credible manner across Queensland.

Council considers a range of factors in determining suitable speed limits in urban areas and makes such decisions in consultation with Queensland Police and the State Government's Transport and Main Roads department.
