Bicentennial Bikeway Upgrade – Stage Two Project commencement

I am writing to advise that Stage Two of the Bicentennial Bikeway Upgrade project will commence in April 2010 and be completed in August 2010, weather permitting.

This upgrade is part of Lord Mayor Campbell Newman's commitment for Brisbane City Council to provide \$100 million in new bikeway infrastructure over four years.

Stage Two construction works will involve upgrading the section of bikeway between Lang Parade and Land Street Auchenflower (approximately 500 metres). It includes a 3.5m-wide cycle path and a 2m-wide pedestrian path to enable separate pedestrian and cyclist movements.

The attached flyer details temporary access changes required for pedestrians and cyclists during construction.

Brisbane City Council is progressively upgrading the Bicentennial Bikeway, Brisbane's busiest bikeway, which runs along the Brisbane River and connects the CBD to Toowong. The project has also received funding from the Department of Transport and Main Roads Cycle Network Program and has been included in the *South East Queensland Infrastructure Plan and Program*.

Council apologises for any inconvenience and thanks you for your patience during construction.
