Temporary access changes

Brisbane City Council is upgrading pedestrian and cycle facilities in South Brisbane, including Kurilpa Park.

Work will commence in early December 2010 and is expected to be completed by April 2011, weather permitting.

Construction hours will be between 7am and 5pm Monday to Saturday. Some construction work may need to be undertaken Sundays and at nights.

Pedestrian access through Kurilpa Park will be maintained during daylight hours only.

During construction, please use the following diversions:

- pedestrians are advised to use the footpath along Montague Road after dusk
- cyclists must detour to the on-road cyclist route via Montague Road.

This project involves widening the existing pathway to 3.5 metres and making it a dedicated bike path, installing a 1.8 metre wide pedestrian footpath along the riverfront and installing lighting to improve safety.

This project is a part of Lord Mayor Campbell Newman's commitment for Brisbane City Council to provide \$100 million in new bikeway infrastructure over four years.
